MEC SKHOSANA CONGRATULATES THE MANTJOLO TRADITIONAL COUNCIL FOR THEIR 20 YEARS ANNIVESARY

MEC for Co-operative Governance and Traditional Affairs (COGTA) in Mpumalanga, Hon. Simon Skhosana has congratulated Inkhosi Bheki Mnisi of the Mantjolo Tribal Council in his 20th anniversary. The anniversary to mark the day in which Inkhosi Mnisi was installed as Senior Traditional Leader of the Mantjolo tribe in April 1994, was held at Enkhonjaneni near Badplaas. The anniversary coincided with the country's 20 years celebration of democracy.
