PREMIER'S ANNUAL ADDRESS TO THE PROVINCIAL HOUSE OF TRADITIONAL LEADERS AND SIGNING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON LAND USE MANAGEMENT

- To ensure that the Traditional Council, in conjunction with Municipalities identify and planned land use and land management schemes.
- To facilitate the involvement of the Municipality during the process of land use and land management within the traditional community.
- To ensure that SAPS enforce law and order in areas of jurisdiction of traditional leaders.
- Ensure that SAPS assist with the process of combating unlawful land invasion.
