HHOYI TRADITIONAL COUNCIL CULTURAL UMMEMO

The Deputy Minister for Co-operative Governance and Traditional Affairs (COGTA), Mr Obed Bapela and MEC for COGTA in Mpumalanga, Ms Refilwe Mtshweni will address the annual Hhoyi Traditional Council cultural ummemo on saturday. The focus of their speeches will be the support to Amakhosi and the importance of strengthening the partnership between traditional leaders and government institutions to improve the socio-economic status of tribal communities and social cohesion.
